

Hungary Visa Application Checklist

Documentation cannot be older than three months, based on your arrival date in Schengen area.

| 1. | Passport must be issued within the previous 10 years and its validity shall extend at least three months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen Area. Must have at least 2 blank pages left for inserting the visa (not necessarily next to each other). | |
| 2. | Color photocopy of passport and your previous Schengen visas for the last 5 years, as well as any valid UK and American visas. | |
| 3. | 2 recent passport size color photographs between 3.5 cm wide and 4.5 cm long, white background. Please stick one photo to the application form and clip on with the form | |
| 4. | Photocopy of re-entry permission to Canada, i.e. Permanent Residence Card, Canada Visa etc. The re-entry permission must be valid for at least 3 months from the exit date from Schengen area. | |
| 5. | Notarized letter of consent if minor travelling without a parent or guardian. Must include the parent or guardian's passport data pages. If both parents are not travelling with the child, a notarized letter of consent is required. Birth certificate for all minors, must indicate the names of both parents. Notarized Translated Birth Certificate if original document is in some other language than English | |
| 6. | Letter from employer confirming start date and continued employment. Must be dated, signed and cannot be more than 90 days old. Must be on letterhead. If you are self-employed please submit your business registration. or Letter of enrolment from educational institution indicating start and end date of your studies. | |
| 7. | Booked flight ticket (including return flight) must be presented when application is submitted | |
| 8. | Hotel/hostel reservation. Must show your full name (as it appears in your passport), must cover each day of your stay in the Schengen area. If the hotel bookings are in the name of a travel companion, a signed letter of support must be submitted along with a copy of this person's passport data page. | |
| 9. | Proof of sufficient funds for the stay in the host country, including most recent 90 days of transactions or notarized letter of support and bank statement from parent, relative etc. who covers the cost of the trip. | |

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| 10. | Proof of travel medical insurance (coverage of at least 30.000 EUR, equivalent to approximately 45.000 CAD) & \$0 Deductible | |

| 11. | For EU/EEA family member, supporting documents are – 1. EU/EEA national family member's passport or ID card 2. an official certificate of the relationship (for spouses of Hungarian citizens, only a marriage certificate issued by Hungary is acceptable) 3. flight ticket if you are travelling together, or an <u>official invitation letter</u> from the family member, issued by the Hungarian Office of Immigration and Nationality. | |
